INTERNATIONAL WINTER SCHOOL

Reading the historic

framework:

interpretation and design

The Winter School provides the opportunity to analyse the features of local entities, in terms of both urban planning and construction, found within the existing historic framework, using the primary tools and methods of cognition, through both documentation and direct observation, under an approach that combines theoretical and operational considerations. The end goal is to provide the student with the tools needed to correctly carry out an all-encompassing analysis, in the interests of a project for the preservation of urban contexts.

Programme Structure

The Winter School consists of two independent: lectures and workshop taught in English, with a final presentation of the work. Guided visits are indeed foreseen at important artistic and monumental sites (Terme di Diocleziano in Rome, Villa d'Este and Villa Gregoriana in Tivoli, near Rome).

Credits

Certificate of participation for 125 hours of activities corresponding to 5 ECTS.

Participants

We welcome undergraduate and graduate students from all over the world with a background in Architecture, Civil Engineering, Archeology, History of Art or related disciplines.

Deadlines

Deadline for submission of application and *Curriculum vitae et studiorum*: August 26th 2016.

Publication of the list of admitted applicants August 29th 2016.

Deadline for payment of tuition fee: September 2th 2016.

Accommodation

Students will be accommodated in comfortable houses in the historic core, in single or double room with private bathroom.

Meals

All the meals will be served in the dining hall. There will be a light, Italian breakfast. Lunch and dinner meals will include a variety of typical Italian dishes.

Service

A study room in the castle will be available for students to study alone or in groups. Wireless internet connection is available on historic center free of charge for those who bring their own laptop or devices.

Sports and Recreation

Ciciliano is surrounded by nature. Beautiful trails run through the forest, those are ideal for walking and jogging. The trails in the surrounding mountains are well marked and safe. The village offers a number of pubs for the evening entertainment, plus a cinema at the municipal theater.

Tuition fees and living expenses

Tuition fees cost 800 EUR. School activities, accommodation, meals, visits, lecture material and medical are included in the tuition fees. Participants are responsible for their travel expenses.
